Bryan made connections with the group hosting the conference in Spokane, WA. They were also able to connect with Leslie Jordan and review promotional items for the SRRC to consider. Ashworth awards was approached about making a special medal for the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the half marathon. Met with different registration companies and learned about virtual race packets.

Cinco De Mayo – 74 registered but more than that showed up. Good time reported by all.

WDF directors Donna Brayfield and Marilyn Clark gave an update on the race. They are planning to get trophies this year for kids. Discussed sponsorships and promoting at other SRRC events. Would like to donate money to Ronald McDonald House with proceeds.

Abe Army's budget was reviewed. Derek invited to June meeting.

Scholarship update: Club received 9 applications from students attending SHG, SHS, Porta, Rochester and GHS. Bryan reviewed scores. Agreed to provide \$3,000 in total scholarships. The top applicant will receive \$1,000 and four others will receive \$500. Three other applicants will receive free registration for club races for one year.

For the SRRC Annual Dinner in January, Board approved having Chris McDougal (Born to Run author) as keynote speaker and a budget not to exceed \$14,000.

Moon light run June 22 and Sliders game July 13. Registration is live on GMR.
